Parkland County has generously donated the use of Meridian Sports Park for the weekend so please take care of it. Thank you to Parkland County.
- 3. All teams play a total of 2 games.
- 4. Coaches will flip a coin to determine home team.
- 5. Each home team for softball are to provide 1 new softball.
- 6. Umpires are provided through the league for the 9 Plus only.
- 7. <u>Ball games</u> 4-5 Years will be 1 hour in length. 6-8 & 9-10 & 11 Plus games will be 1-1/2 hours in length. There is a warm-up period <u>to a maximum</u> of 30 minutes.
- 8. All tournament rules are the same as the rules used throughout the regular season.
- 9. Prior to the game beginning, umpires will discuss any interpretations of the rules with the coaches. The umpire's decision will be final.
- 10. <u>Concession:</u> Shelley Semler will run the concession. <u>No barbecues</u> are allowed on the Meridian Sports Park grounds.
- 11. Washrooms are on-site.
- 12. **No camping:** No camping or trailers will be available in the main parking lot or on site this year. Sorry for the inconvenience, but we have too many teams and not enough parking to make this available.
- 13. **No Pets:** Absolutely no pets are allowed in the Park. Please make everyone aware.
- 14. If the weather is hot, please bring umbrellas. Lawn chairs may be needed depending upon how many spectators are using the bleachers.
- 15. **<u>Rainout Policy</u>**: No games will be rescheduled. Rainouts will be decided on site. The safety of players and diamond/field condition will be the deciding factors that will be used to determine rainouts.




