 30-minute periods for u13



- 10. Concession: Shelley Semler will run the concession
- 11. No barbecues are allowed on the Meridian Sports Park grounds.
- 12. Washrooms are on-site.
- 13. <u>No Pets:</u> Absolutely no pets are allowed in the Park. Please inform your team.
- 14. **No camping:** No camping or trailers will be available in the main parking lot or on site.. Sorry for the inconvenience but we have too many teams to make this available.
- 15. Water will be available to purchase from the concession. If the weather is hot, please bring umbrellas. Lawn chairs may be needed if there are many spectators using the bleachers or if the games are on field #2 there are no bleachers there.
- 16. <u>Rainout Policy:</u> No games will be rescheduled. Rainouts will be decided on site. The safety of players and diamond/field condition will be the deciding factors that will be used to determine rainouts.


